

F. Impact on National and Local Policy

Example: Christopher and colleagues research conducted at Juniper Gardens Children's Project on seatbelts and care seat restraints for young children contributed to the State of Kansas' adoption of seatbelt laws for this young, at risk population.

Example: Hart and Risley's findings reported in the book *Meaningful Differences in the Everyday Experiences of American Children* have been cited by the first lady's in the Clinton and Bush Administrations as examples of what is known about language and learning to talk.

Example: Greenwood, Carta, and Walker's work in the Early Childhood Outcome Center for Infants, Toddlers, and Preschoolers with Disabilities is guiding the national agenda on program accountability and States monitoring of progress of Individuals with Disabilities Act (Part C and Part B programs) that serve young children with disabilities.
